EVENT

The First Nations of Quebec and Labrador Sustainable Development Institute (FNQLSDI) is organizing the First Nations of Quebec Waste Management Symposium on **January 23 and 24, 2018**, in Quebec City.

The event's main objective is to offer the opportunity for key members of waste management in First Nation communities to gather in order to share their point of view on current issues and on the realities they face through presentations, conferences and discussion workshops.

This event will also allow participants to discuss their achievements and to gain additional knowledge on the existing provincial and federal waste management programs. The event will be held over two days and will cover the four following topics:

1. Waste Management Administrative Aspects
2. « Ecocentres » Management
3. Composting
4. Infrastructure and Operations

The covered topics include redistribution of charges payable for waste disposal, available funding programs, costs and regulations in communities and management of municipal-type service agreements. Optimization of operations as well as improvement strategies will also be addressed. A detailed agenda will be sent shortly.

ACCOMMODATION

The claimant will be reimbursed at an equal or lower cost than the price of the block of rooms reserved by the FNQLSDI.

EXPENSES

Accommodation, meals and incidentals will be reimbursed for two (2) persons per First Nations community. **However, travel expenses (transportation) will be reimbursed for one (1) person per First Nations community to encourage carpooling. *Please note that airfare will not be reimbursed without prior written permission of the director of the FNQLSDI.** The people designated by the Chief and Band Council will have reimbursement priority. Any other First Nations members or representatives are welcome, but they must bear the costs of their own expenses. Please see the terms of reimbursement on the appropriate form.
